SUSTAINABILITY TIP FROM THE CREATION CARE MINISTRY

Sign up to "Build Your Own Rain Barrel" Workshop at the Charles E. Beatley Jr. Central Library (5005 Duke Street) *this Saturday*, August 3, 2024, from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The City recommends using rain barrels to collect and store runoff from roofs that would otherwise flow into the storm sewer network. The use of residential rain barrels provides several benefits, including:

- •Reducing your municipal water bill by using saved water from rain barrels instead of tap water for home landscaping and car washing.
- •Protecting the Chesapeake Bay by using stored rainwater in the garden which will absorb slowly into the ground, replenishing precious groundwater supplies.

Qualifying your residence for credits towards your <u>Stormwater Utility Fee (SWU)</u> if rain barrels are installed and properly used. Click on the link for more information on how to apply for the <u>SWU Credit</u> Program.

To attend the workshop, residents must first register on the <u>Northern Virginia Soil and Water Conservation</u> <u>website</u>. Space is limited.
